G20 Summit Report

Date: 9th September 2023-10th September 2023



Ramanujan College students had a remarkable opportunity to participate in the G20 Summit held in New Delhi, showcasing their dedication and organizational skills. The journey began with a rigorous interview process, where 250 students from diverse backgrounds in Sector 57, Noida, vied for a chance to represent their institution. The event was managed by Aksh Gupta and Stuti Jain.

Pavilion Interiors in Sector 57, Noida, conducted interviews, assessing students based on attire and presentation. Selected candidates were promptly prepared. HR held an online meeting to brief them on responsibilities. Volunteers received formal attire, technical tools, and facilities for seamless coordination, enabling them to excel in their pivotal roles.

Day 1: The main event on September 9th showcased student commitment. Forty volunteers split into three levels at the Mandapam. Level 1 (10 volunteers) managed guest queries and delegate meetings. Level 2 (18 volunteers) handled entry gates and delegate inquiries. Level 3 (12 volunteers) escorted delegates and addressed queries in the dinner hall during the evening shift.

Day 2: The second day, September 10th, featured additional bilateral meetings. Level 1 volunteers continued their essential role in assisting delegates, while Level 2 volunteers ensured a seamless departure process. Level 3 volunteers had no duties on this day as no dinner event was planned.

The volunteers were well-supported throughout the event. They received formal attire, technical gadgets, breakfast, and dinner facilities. Accommodation was arranged for 42 students, and transportation was provided to and from the venue. Additional cab services were even offered by the organizers of the G20 Summit.
