Although there are many factors that affect health of an individual, a large number of studies suggest that life style has a significant role in determining one's health or illness.

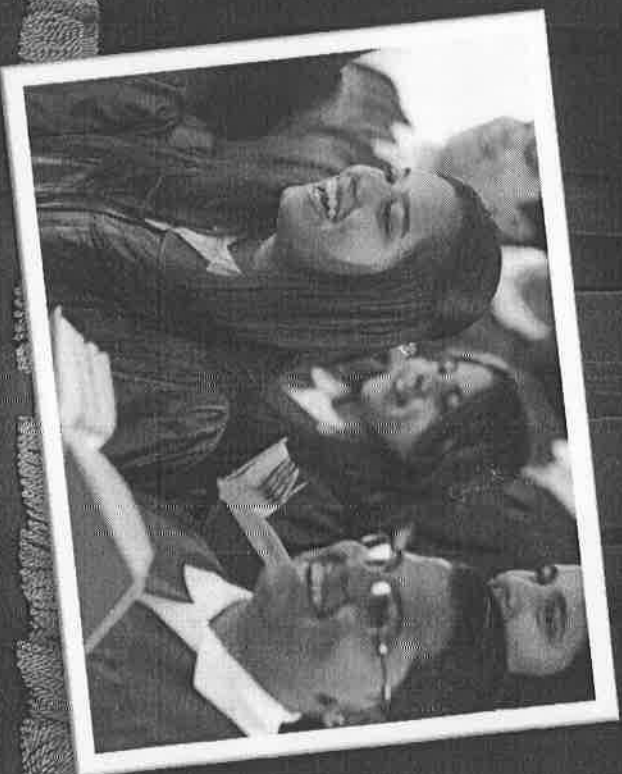

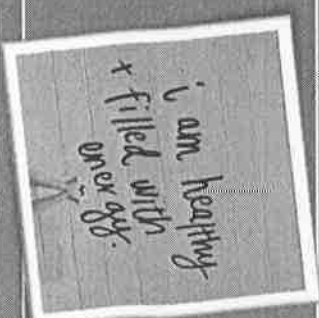

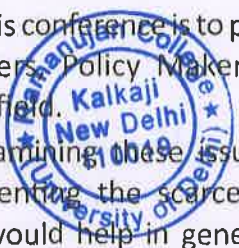

About the Conference

This conference marks an important event in the roadmap towards providing due cognisance to the novel initiatives taken up by the Government of India (GOI) particularly 'Make in India' and 'Start-up India', their impact on Indian economy along with the associated contemporary issues, lessons learnt from past, plausible future challenges, emerging trends, opportunities and solutions. This is conceptualized to be highly interactive and is expected to provide information to all the stakeholders' particularly young entrepreneurs and industry. The objective of this conference is to provide a knowledge sharing platform on this theme to Academicians, Researchers, Policy Makers, Practitioners, Industry Experts, Entrepreneurs, and Knowledge Patrons of the field.

This conference will lay its emphasis on examining these issues using well established research methodologies. Besides substantially augmenting the scarce academic literature and body of knowledge on the subject, this conference would help in generating solutions to the current and

prospective challenges, as well as, providing practical and pertinent inputs to Policy Makers, Regulators, Industrialists, and young Entrepreneurs. Further, due to the participatory nature of the conference, it is expected that the results and implications drawn from it would get further improvised in future according to the evolving scenario.

Concept Note

Indian Economy has been undergoing massive transformation in recent times. India has now become the fastest growing major economy in the world, overtaking China. Service sector has been the flag bearer of the Indian growth story, whereas, the agriculture sector has shown modest growth. After, two continuous years of drought, we had good monsoon in 2016. This has heightened expectations of a strong rural income and demand. The Goods and Services Tax (GST) bill which was recently passed by both houses and is likely to be enforced in July 2017. It is expected to add further 1-2% to GDP growth rate. Indian National Rupee (INR) has been relatively stable vis-à-vis other global currencies. Our foreign exchange reserves recently touched record high levels. But on the flip side, export has been declining continuously for past several quarters, mainly due to slowdown in global demand and low commodity prices. Growth in our industrial production has also been either very low or even negative for some crucial sectors such as capital goods. This had spill over effect on the balance sheets of several banks in form of higher NPAs. Also, the proposition of "Jobless Growth" is gaining ground with marginal growth in employment, particularly in the organised sector. "Automation" and "Artificial Intelligence" is expected to replace lakhs of low and middle levels jobs in Corporate India over the next few years, while adding comparatively lesser jobs in return. India will soon have the largest young workforce in the world. If adequately skilled and groomed for contemporary challenges and complexities, they will prove to be the "Demographic Dividend" and biggest strength for our economy.

Robust policy framework, good governance, and active Government support is essential for achieving and sustaining a high level economic growth which is also inclusive. Thus, to rejuvenate the slowing industrial/manufacturing sector, address growing criticism of "Jobless Growth", boost employment, create a start-up ecosystem and sustain the rapid pace of economic growth, the Government of India has in recent past come up with a few significant policy majors such as Make in India and Start-up India.

I. Make in India: The "Make in India" an initiative was launched by the Government of India to encourage multi-nationals, as well as, national companies to manufacture their products and services in India. As per the new Govt. Policy, 100% FDI is permitted in sectors, except for space, defence, and news media. The application for licenses was made available online, and the validity of licences was increased to three years. Various other norms and procedures were also relaxed to improve the "Ease of Doing Business" in India. India has emerged, after the initiation of the programme in 2015, as the top destination globally for foreign direct investment, surpassing the United States of America, and the People's Republic of China.

II. Start-up India: "Start-up India" campaign is based on an action plan aimed at promoting bank financing for start-up ventures to boost entrepreneurship and encourage start-ups with jobs creation. This initiative aims at fostering entrepreneurship and promoting innovation by creating an ecosystem that is conducive for growth of Start-ups. The objective is that India must become a nation of job creators instead of being a nation of job seekers. A Start-up is an entity that is headquartered in India, which was opened less than five years ago, and has an annual turnover less than 25 crore (US\$3.7 million). The government has already launched iMADE, an app development platform aimed at producing 1,000,000 apps, and the MUDRA Bank, a new institution set up for development and refinancing activities relating to micro units with a refinance fund of 200 billion (US\$3.0 billion). The Stand-up India initiative is also aimed at promoting entrepreneurship among SCs, STs, communities, Rural India's version of Start-up India was named the Deen Dayal Upadhyay Swanidhi Yojana.

5. An author cannot submit more than 2 articles.

Developing Transformational Skills

Program Idea Note:

Technology today is developing at exponential rate while thinking is growing at linear rate. To regulate the pace of technology, there is a need for the teachers to do exponential thinking. Teachers need the skill to transcend beyond formal learning or teaching. Learning or knowledge that simply serves the purpose of worldly existence is now easily available in the air. In the given situation, to reinstate legitimacy, a teacher needs to resume their predecessor's role of 'Guru' who could inspire students to transform blissfully. Inspiration to transform connects one to the interior self; while motivation to perform connects one to the ulterior self. And it is ethical values that have got inherent potential of transforming spirit of motivation into inspiration. The biggest challenge, however, is to find many teachers and seekers of ethics. This is largely because most of us have become dishonest and thus consider honesty/ethics as fossils of museums or sermons of sadhus or unpractical subjects of the real world. We refuse to admit that in the real world we have become untrue or unreal. We are stuck in a millennial generation where loyalty is just a tattoo, love is just a quote, and lying is the new truth. We don't want a rule of ethicists, but a rule of the 'opportunists' who don't have 'the vision of truth', who don't know the true forms of Justice, Beauty and 'the good' and can't try to mould 'the world' accordingly.

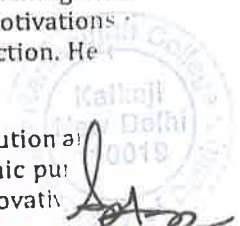
Skills of a Teacher:

In modern education, the job of a teacher has become very complex. Different types of skills are required to teach effectively in a dynamic environment. These skills of a teacher have been classified into three categories, namely technical, human and enterprising skills.

Technical skill: It refers to the ability and knowledge of a teacher in using the pedagogy, tools and techniques involved in teaching specific subject. Ability in programming and operating a computer is, for instance, a technical skill. Teachers need technical skill to educate and train students. There are two things a teacher should understand about technical skills. In the first place, he must know which skill and what level of skill should be applied on particular student and be familiar enough with their potentiality to ask discerning questions. Secondly, a teacher must understand the role of each event organized and skill applied; and the inter-relationships between the events and skills.

Human Skill: It consists of the ability to teach effectively with, understand and inspire students both as individuals and as members of a class. Such a skill is required to win cooperation of students and to build effective study teams. Such skills require a sense of feeling for students and capacity to look at things from their point of view. A teacher with human skills is sufficiently sensitive to the needs and motivations of students so that he can judge the possible reaction to and outcome of various courses of action. He can resolve intra and inter group conflicts.

Enterprising Skill: It comprises the ability of a teacher to see the perspective of entire institution and inter-relationships between its parts. This skill refers to the ability to visualize the academic picture as a whole or to consider a situation in totality. These skills involve understanding abstract or innovative

constructing models and relationships, and anticipating economic implications of planned actions. It is the intellectual ability to coordinate and integrate all the institutional interests and activities. Such skills help the teacher to conceptualize the needs of the society, environment, and to analyse forces working in a situation. It also includes the competence to understand a problem in all its aspects and to use original thinking in solving the problem.
