#### Dear Colleagues,

For the first time admissions for the academic session 2020-21 were totally online right from applying to the University of Delhi to final admissions in the college.



Online admission has its advantages as it is very convenient for applicants, especially outstation applicants. It is even beneficial for the colleges as there is no public dealing and the same work is done more efficiently with lesser resources. It is even beneficial for the environment as a lot of commuting was saved and over that, a lot of paper and other natural resources were saved.

Although the online system has made the admission simple but adopting to the online system was not easy as the whole computer interface was introduced for the first time and University made live the software on the first day of admission so there was no time for staff training, which made it a bit challenging. But with time the staff became adaptable to the whole new system.

## Guidelines for students applying for Special Cut-Off

- 1) Following applicants will be eligible/ not eligible to participate in the Special Cut-Off
  - a) Only those applicants will be considered who could not/did not take admission in the initial five Cut-Offs for whatsoever reasons.
  - b) An applicant who has cancelled his/ her admission in the 5<sup>th</sup> Cut-Off will not be eligible to participate in the special Cut-Off.
  - c) Applicants who are already admitted (including NCWEB) in any course/ college of University of Delhi will not be eligible to participate in the special Cut-Off.
- 2) Applicants will apply to a single college + course. Applicants must ensure that they have carefully checked the number of seats vacant in the course + college they are applying to under their category.
- 3) The Cut-Off for various courses available under each category for a college who would be admitting students under Special Cut-Off wil be available on the website of University of Delhi on 23<sup>rd</sup> Nov 2020 (Mon).
- 4) In case the number of applicants applying for a particular course in a college is more than the number of seats available, colleges will make a merit as per the Best of Four/ Best of three required for the course. The college will approve only those number of applicants as per the merit, as the number of seats available.
- 5) In case of a tie for a seat the following tie-breaking rule shall be applied
  - a) The applicant with higher percentage of marks (aggregate of best five subjects including one language) in the qualifying examination will be considered first for admission. [57]
  - b) The applicant with the earlier date of birth (as mentioned in class X certificate) will be considered for admission.
- 6) Merely applying under the Special Cut-Off does not guarantee an admission to the applicant.
- 7) No grievances will be entertained in case an applicant fails to apply or pay the fees (if approved) within the stipulated time period given in the schedule.

3 Procedure for the applying students and the procedure followed by college for processing the applications

#### **Procedure for Students:**

- Upon declaration of a Cut-Off, the applicants will log in to their Dashboards and choose one course and college **from 10AM on the day cut off is live** they wish to claim admission in from the list of colleges and courses they are eligible for.
- The applicant will choose one course and one college where he/ she meets the cut-off and the eligibility criteria. It is up to the applicant to which course s/he applies.

#### **Procedure for the College:**

Step 1: Best four calculation and the number of documents that are uploaded by the applicant are complete. This will be performed by Teachers and TIC of a department on duty.

- **Step 1.1**: Log in to the portal. Username and password was shared with TICs through mail and SMS.
- Step 1.2: After successful log in, check for the applicants where the application status is "New Application".
- Step 1.3: Check for all the documents that are uploaded by the applicants.
  - In case all the documents are not uploaded then mail and call such applicants and ask them to send the required documents to department email address. Leave the admission status to "New Application" only. and wait for the documents.
  - Incase such applicants fail to provide document by 5PM on the last day of cut off then change the admission status to "Application Rejected"
  - Incase all the documents are uploaded by the applicant then proceed with best four calculation.
  - Note: Teachers just have to check whether all the documents are uploaded or not, they do not have to check validity of any documents.
- Step 1.4: Now one by one check the application for best four calculation as per the criteria given in the Bulletin of Information 2020
  - In case applicant is **eligible (Meeting the cut off and have uploaded all the documents)** then change the status to **"Pending Documents Verification"**
  - In case applicant is ineligible due to not meeting the cut off then change the status to "Application Rejected"
  - In case the documents are not complete and you are waiting for the documents then leave the status to "New Application"

Step 2: Verification of documents by the non-teaching staff, for only those applicants that are forwarded by the Teachers and TIC of a department.

- **Step 2.1**: Log in to the portal. Username and password will be shared with staff via SMS.
- **Step 2.2**: After successful log in, check for the applicants whose status is **"Pending Documents Verification"** by applying filter for status in Application Status.
- **Step 2.3:** One by one check the application for authenticity of certificates.

#### **Certificate 1: Marksheet**

- Check the marks on the website of the class XII board.

- In case applicant's certificates are authentic then change the status to "Documents Verified"
- In case applicant's certificates are not authentic then change the status to "Application Rejected"
- Step 3: Recommendation by Admission convener for the cases forwarded by the staff after Verification of documents.
- **Step 3.1**: Log in to the portal. Username and password will be shared with Convener through SMS.
- Step 3.2: After successful log in, check for the applicants whose status is "Documents Verified" by applying filter for status in Application Status
- Step 3.3: Check for all the documents that are uploaded by the applicants.
  - In case all the documents are uploaded properly and the applicant is eligible then change the admission status of such applicants to "Verified by convener"
  - In case the applicant is not eligible then change the status to "Application Rejected"
  - No application to be left undecided. It has to be either Approved or Declined before declaring the next cutoff.

Step 4: Final approval by the Principal for the cases forwarded by the admission convener.

#### 11 Observations from admission procedure:

#### 1. For vacant seats:

#### a. Under EWS category:

EWS seats were vacant in all sixteen courses as only few applications were under EWS, even after substantially reducing EWS cut-off. The situation is same in most of the University of Delhi colleges. The reason for this is that the applicants were not able to apply for EWS certificate in lockdown and could not apply under EWS category during application process of University of Delhi.

**b.** Under OBC, SC and ST category: The vacant seat status is almost similar to last year.

#### 2. For cancellation and withdrawal:

It is observed that major cancellation happened from first and second cut-off which means admission in college got settled from fourth cut-off. This is an improvement over last year admissions as last year college got settled from fifth cut-off.
