Analysis of Student Feedback Form for Teachers (2020-2021)



Description of ratings is as follows:-


- 1 Strongly Disagree


Q2. The teacher encourages participation and discussion in class. (Teacher-Student, Student-Student).








Q4. The teacher pays attention to academically weaker students as well.






Q6. The teacher invites opinion and questions on subject matter from students.




Q8. The teacher links the subject to real life experiences and creates interest in the subject.




Q10. The teacher explains the topics efficiently.


