Annual Report

Dear friends, distinguished guests, colleagues and students, on behalf of the College I welcome you all on the auspicious occasion of the 59th Annual Day and Prize Giving Ceremony of Ramanujan College. It gives me immense pleasure to especially welcome Prof. J. P. Khurana, our distinguished chief guest and Shri Shashank, the chairman of our College as the respected guest of honour today. I also heartily welcome the esteemed members of the governing body of our College, the specially invited guests, my teaching and non-teaching colleagues, the alumni of the College present here and all the students of Ramanujan College to this formal function.

Our distinguished chief guest today, Prof. Jitendra Paul Khurana is currently the Pro Vice Chancellor of the University of Delhi. He is also the Director, South Campus of the University of Delhi. A professor of plant molecular biology, Prof. Khurana is an accomplished scientist having completed his post-doctoral research from the famous Smithsonian Institution in Washington DC, and the Michigan State University. He had the honour of being a visiting professor at the Waksman Institute of Microbiology at the Rutgers University, USA. He has served as a member in the committees of several important institutions of science and technology like the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Department of Science and Technology (DST), Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) and the Indian Council for Agricultural Research (ICAR). Prof. Khurana has been honoured as the Fellow of the National Academy of Sciences, Allahabad; Fellow of the Indian National Science Academy, New Delhi; Fellow of the Indian Academy of Sciences, Bangalore; Fellow of the National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi and the Fellow of the World Academy of Sciences (TWAS), Italy. Prof. Khurana has been awarded the 'Tata Innovation Fellowship' by the Department of Biotechnology and, currently, he is the J.C. Bose National Fellow of the Department of Science and Technology. Sir, we are indeed privileged to have you amongst us on this special day.

The chairman of the governing body of our College, Shri Shashank is an illustrious officer of the Indian Foreign Service. He retired as the Foreign Secretary of India, the highest rank in the Indian Foreign Service. In a diplomatic career spanning four decades, he has represented India as her ambassador in the countries of Denmark, Republic of Korea, Libya and Malta. Before such ambassadorial appointments, he distinguished himself with key assignments in Africa, America, Asia and Europe. He is widely regarded as an architect of India's economic diplomacy and for strengthening relationships with the nations in Africa and East Asia. He was presently a visiting professor at the Jawaharlal Nehru University's School of International Studies and also served as the chairman of the Association of African Studies in India. He was the president of the Indian Council for International Cooperation and India-Republic of Korea Friendship Association. He is an advisor to several leading universities, chambers of commerce, non-governmental organizations, think tanks and corporations on international relations. Sir, we are truly honoured by your esteemed presence with us today.

After the focused preparations for the NAAC Peer team visit last year, the year 2016-17 has

been a year of consolidation as well as expansion. I take this opportunity to apprise you of the many important developments that have taken place in the College since the last Annual Day.

The construction of the new building of the College is going on at a hectic pace. RITES who are the project management consultants have assured that the finished building will be handed over by the middle of this year. The new building will provide thirty two rooms to be used as classrooms, laboratories, staff rooms, and a medium sized indoor auditorium. It will be supported by a gigantic service center with provision of a sewage treatment plant, electric sub-station and power generators, water storage tanks and pumps. However, it is perhaps pertinent to remind ourselves that this building is only a portion of the entire plan and layout of our College. The total project cost is about Rs. 140 crores, out of which, as of now, we could manage only Rs. 20 crores which has gone towards this part of the building construction. This building alone will not suffice for our future requirements. Hence, we earnestly request the concerned authorities to grant us funds for further construction.

With the beginning of the construction of the new building of the College, special care had to be taken to ensure that construction activity did not hamper the smooth functioning of the College. We constructed new porta cabins to add eight extra rooms to the already existing porta cabins. Large areas of the College space had to be cordoned off for the purposes of safety and security. I appreciate the fact that the teachers, students and the non teaching staff have whole heartedly cooperated during this period when the construction work is going on.

We feel proud that our College with modest infrastructural facilities is able to outreach and host three learning centers, namely, the University of Delhi's School of Open Learning (SOL) for about 1000 students; the Non Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB) of the University of Delhi catering to about 600 students and the Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) Study Center providing facilities to 1500 students. Our College is also offering coaching facilities to students for various competitive examinations for selection in banks, Staff Selection Commission (SSC) and the civil services. About 200 students are benefitting from this initiative.

This year the prestigious professional course of Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS) run by the Faculty of Applied Social Sciences and Humanities, University of Delhi, has been introduced as a regular undergraduate course in our College. We are one amongst the four colleges in the University of Delhi to be running the BMS course. Our College also had the distinction of being selected as the nodal center to oversee the entire admission process of Bachelor of Business Studies (BMS), Bachelor of Business Economics (BBE) and the Bachelor of Business Administration (Financial and Investment Analysis [(BBA (FIA)] courses for all the colleges of University where these courses are being offered. Almost 5,000 shortlisted candidates appeared for the selection process that included group discussion and personal interviews. The mammoth exercise involved more than hundred teachers, professionals and industry experts. The successful conduct of the entire rigorous selection process beginning with the student's registration, verification of documents, group discussion and finally the personal interviews within two hours for each individual student without any glitches is a real accomplishment, especially so because it was the first time that such a mega event was organized by the College. I congratulate the team of dedicated teachers and volunteers of the College for this remarkable achievement.

The Deen Dayal Upadhyay Center for Knowledge Acquisition and Upgradation of Skilled Human Abilities and Livelihood (KAUSHAL Kendra), sanctioned by UGC last year has admitted its first batch of students this year. Our College, the only institution in the University of Delhi running a KAUSHAL Kendra, is offering two Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) courses. They are Banking Operations and Software Development. A specially designed curriculum has been formulated with expert advice from both academic faculties and industry experts aimed at providing the students both academic and technical expertise and knowledge.

Other than Management Studies, five new disciplines as honours courses were approved and sanctioned by the University of Delhi. These courses, namely, Mathematics, Statistics, Computer Science, Applied Psychology and Philosophy have commenced with the first year class. There is very high demand for admission in these courses as was evident from cut offs that have been higher than 90%. The honours course in Economics has been approved and will commence from the coming academic session. It is with some pride that I must say that the inspection committee from the Delhi School of Economics were greatly impressed with the infrastructure, library, e-resources, laboratory facilities, wi-fi access and the faculty of the College and expressed it in their report.

With the objective of all round development of students and providing more opportunities, the College is offering add-on courses. An MOU has been signed with the software company Tally for training students on Tally ERP 9. The National Skill Development Council (NSDC) is running a course on Associate Analytics. The second batch of the three month diploma course on International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) in association with the Indian Accounting Association (NCR Chapter) has been started. E-Learning content management system has been developed on an open source platform – MOODLE which enables submission of assignments, uploading of tests and evaluation. The department of Hindi in association with the KAUSHAL Kendra has started a certificate course on Mass Media. Another certificate course on Radio Broadcasting is successfully running in its second year. The Centre for Human Rights Studies has concluded the fourth session (August – November, 2016) of the UGC-sponsored three months certificate course on Human Rights.

The department of Commerce publishes the journal "Ramanujan International Journal of Business and Research" and is in the process of publishing its second edition. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College launched its newsletter for the dissemination of important and relevant information about the College and its activities. The newsletter provides our College's profile and achievements. The IQAC has recommended the institution of the "Ramanujan College Achievement Awards" for promoting and encouraging research, innovative pedagogic practices, administrative reforms and other significant academic contributions of merit. To encourage research among students the IQAC has recommended the provision of seed money of Rs. 2 lakhs for the self-initiated student's projects. Rs. 5 lakhs has been allocated by the College for minor research projects. The College has also allocated Rs. 5 lakhs for filing patent and copyrights at national and international level.

Five University of Delhi sponsored three year star innovation projects are progressing satisfactorily and are now in their second year. The seven Innovation Projects sanctioned by University of Delhi were successfully completed within the stipulated time and the reports have been submitted. At the College level, the College Research Committee has sanctioned five inter-disciplinary projects involving students and teachers. A large number of our

teachers are engaged in research activities. They are regularly publishing their research works in reputed national and international journals. The College has also started providing consultancy to outside agencies through a newly formed Research Consultancy and Services Cell. The College provided consultancy services worth Rs. 3 lacs for the State Bank Officers Association in the segregation and counting of the postal ballots through computer systems programmed by the College. The College also provided consultancy worth Rs. 3 lacs for Reliable Data Solutions to perform the confidential work of evaluation and tabulation of answer scripts. Our College has applied for ranking under the National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF) of the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India. We have duly submitted the required data and await the ranking of our College.

Almost all the departments have organized a number of seminars, talks, panel discussions and Faculty Development Programmes for the benefit of the faculty members and students at large. Through such events, they are able to interact with eminent scholars and increase their academic and research acumen. Various centers of the College have been very actively working towards their respective objectives. The Centre for Ethics and Values successfully organized various activities during the past year including the 'Ethics Parliament'. It was the most awaited event under the aegis of "Virasat", their annual festival, which was organized with much fervour for the third time. The Centre for Social Innovation conducted activities focussing on the education of slum children, women empowerment and promoting cleanliness, among others. The Centre for Robotics and Artificial Intelligence is working on emerging areas in the field of robotics, embedded systems and machine intelligence.

The department of Commerce in association with the Jagannath International Management School (JIMS), Kalkaji; the Commerce Association of Jesus and Mary College; the Bombay Stock Exchange and the Indian Accounting Association (NCR Chapter) organised a "Mock Stock Competition" in Ramanujan College which had an interesting format and attractive prizes. It received wide participation. The department of Philosophy has successfully organised a two days International Conference on "Re-Learning to be Human for Global Times: Justice and Responsibility" in collaboration with the Department of Philosophy University of Delhi and the Council for Research in Values and Philosophy; Washington D.C.

Throughout the year teachers have made the College proud with their distinguished achievements. Teachers have successfully guided Ph.D. thesis. Teachers have also been awarded Ph.D. degrees on completing their research. It is matter of honour that one of our senior faculty member from the department of Political Science has been appointed as the professor holding the Ambedkar Chair at the Himachal Central University. One of our teacher from the Department of English was appointed as the consultant for the Pay Review Committee set up by the University Grant Commission (UGC). One of our colleagues from the Department of Computer Science visited the Canberra Institute of Technology, Australia to participate in a week long Australia - India Vocational Education Leadership Training (VELT) program. It was organized by the Australian Embassy in collaboration with the UGC, AICTE and Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship. Another colleague from the department of History visited United States of America (USA) for a one month having been awarded the Early Career Fellowship with the South Asia Center at the University of Pennsylvania. One faculty member from the Department of Economics was awarded the honorarium of Rs. 1 lakh for excellent research under the RBI Scholarship Scheme. Ten faculty members have completed Orientation or Refresher courses during the year.

I must also mention some of the outstanding individual achievements of our students. A team of two BMS first year students, calling themselves the "Paranoid Androids" built an app called "Paisafy" which used mesh networking technology to transfer money without the use of internet. It won the "Hackathon" event at the India – U.K. Tech Summit, 2016 organised jointly by the Governments of India and the UK and got rupees 75,000 in cash prize along with a lot of recognition among the leading startup investors of the country and plenty of media attention. The College is indeed very proud of their achievement. Three other students of BMS went for a 45 day cross cultural internship to Russia. The internship activities ranged from teaching poor children to volunteering for the blind. A final year student of B.Sc. (Hons.) Statistics was shortlisted for the short term Training Program in Department of Bio Statistics of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Delhi. Another student from Computer Science department won the Android Career Summit hosted by Google India and Udacity. He is also working with Tata Trusts on a computer application programme for the betterment of farmers in tribal areas. From the same department a student has been selected by Intern Shala for the profile of Web Developer. Thirty three other students have undertaken internships in various organizations namely DRDO, NIC, NTPC, DMRC, Department of Mathematics and CIC University of Delhi. Students from the department of Computer Science have made significant contributions in developing several softwares such as Android Application "Ramanujan College", online module for registration for student ID card, online feedback system for the students of the College, and a mini Internet of Things Application. A B.Sc. Statistics (Hons.) student was chosen for Vocational Training at Bharat Heavy Electrical Ltd. (BHEL). A student of B.Com. (H) IIInd year went to Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia for "Youth Innovation Lab" which was a two day workshop hosted by the Institute of Strategic Dialogue as a part of the youth civil activism network project in partnership with the Foreign and Commonwealth office. A B.Com. (Hons.) final year student was selected for "Summer Training" at India Trade Promotion Organization (ITPO), a Government of India Organisation. A student of our College has been selected as the best volunteer in the Digital Financial Literacy Campaign by the Ministry of Human Resource and Development, Government of India. The details of all these achievements are in the published Annual Report 2016-17.

Academically the College continues to show remarkable progress. In the academic session 2015-16, a total of 2084 students appeared in the university examinations. I am very happy to report that the pass percentage has gone up significantly from 80% last year to 96% this year. More than 50% of these students have secured first division. Also, as per the latest results available of the November – December, 2016 semester exams, the pass percentage has further improved to 98% and approximately 70% of the students have secured first division.

We have provided a sum of Rs. 1,63,340 by way of Fee Concession and Financial Aid to 88 students. Fee waiver of Rs. 99,275 was also given to 15 students. Students of our College are finding placements in reputed companies. So far in this academic session, more than 100 students have been recruited by companies like ICICI Prudential Life Insurance, Interglobe Technologies, India Infoline, Tech Mahindra, Naukri.Com and Amazon.

The Ramanujan College celebrated its Foundation Day on 22nd December, 2016 which was also the 129th birth anniversary of the great mathematician Srinivasa Aiyangar Ramanujan. Prof. M. L. Singla, Dean, Faculty of Management Studies, University of Delhi was the chief guest for the occasion. The 4th Srinivasa Aiyangar Ramanujan Memorial Lecture was

delivered by the eminent economist, Prof. Ram Singh of Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi on the topic "India: Vision 2050". The lecture was extremely informative and analytical and Prof. Ram keenly interacted with an intellectually vibrant audience.

Ramanujan College Committee endeavours for a meaningful engagement with the larger society. The Outreach Programme of the College aims at benefitting and bringing about a change in the lives of weaker sections of the society. A number of outreach programs have been conducted by individual departments and centers of the College. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed by the College with the NGO Rupantaran, under which the College has adopted two slum camps. Our students will provide teaching services to the children and women residing there, while Rupantaran will provide the infrastructural facilities.

The College celebrated its Annual Inter-College Cultural Festival - Josh 2017. Apart from the various regular competitions, the audience was left enthralled by the performances of band Rangrezza and singer Ikka. The whole event was full of colour, enthusiasm and life. In the context of cultural achievements, Jazba, the College theatre group and First Cut, the College Film society have made the College proud by winning various competitions.

In spite of the non availability of a proper play ground due to the ongoing construction of the new building, the much awaited Annual Athletics Meet 2016-17 was held with enthusiasm and fervor and the available space was used creatively and effectively. The chief guest for the day was Dr. Sunita Godara, an Asian marathon champion (1992), a sports promoter and a social activist. This year the event was unique with participation from students of other colleges. Unconventional inter college competitions in yoga and aerobics were held much to the acclaim from all those present.

This report gives only a glimpse of the innumerable activities and achievements made during the past year. Despite several challenges and impediments, we assure you that this pace of development will only be enhanced in future and we will achieve even higher levels of excellence.

The College looks forward to the next year with keen anticipation as we will be celebrating the diamond jubilee of the College. A number of programmes have been conceptualized to celebrate the year. We are also eager to be a part of two important MHRD initiatives next year. We have applied for the setting up of a Teacher Learning Centre and we have also applied to be a part of the Global Initiative of Academic Networks (GIAN). We are confident that our proposals for both these programme will be accepted.

I congratulate all the prize winners and give my best wishes to students for their upcoming semester examinations. I would like to express my sincere appreciation for the unconditional support and cooperation of all my teaching and non-teaching colleagues and the wonderful students of our college.

Ramanujan college is the only college in Delhi University to have been granted the Deen Dayal Upadhyay Centre for Knowledge Acquisition and Upgradation of Skilled Human Abilities and Livelihood (KAUSHAL) by the UGC, under which the College is offering Bachelor of Vocation Courses in Banking and Financial Services and Information Technology. A specially designed curriculum has been formulated with expert advice from both academic faculties and industry experts. The course has begun with 84 students in B.Voc. (Banking Operations) and 61 in B.Voc. (Software Development) under Information Technology.

Open Day: An Open day was successfully organised by the college on 6th September, 2016 at Ghalib auditorium for those seeking admissions in the B.Voc. and Advanced Diploma courses in the University of Delhi. The event was presided over by Dr. S. P. Aggarwal, Principal, Ramanujan College and Dr. Amrita Bajaj, Deputy Dean, Student Welfare, University of Delhi. Students were introduced to the merits and guided regarding the future potential of B.Voc. and Advanced Diploma courses.

Orientation Day: Orientation day was organised by the College on 27th September, 2016 for the students admitted to the B. Voc. Courses. The students eagerly participated in the event in which they were oriented with the college amenities and teachers.

Classes: The classes for B.Voc. Courses began on 28th September, 2016 which continued on a regular basis till December 20, 2016. A fruitful mix of in-house faculty and industry experts are involved in the conduct of the course.

Examinations & Assessment: The examinations of General Education Component (GEC) for the B.Voc. Courses were held and conducted from 11th January, 2016 to 16th January, 2016. The assessment for the Skill Enhancement Component (SEC) component for B.Voc. (Banking Operations) Course was conducted by BFSI Sector Skill Council certified assessor on 19th January, 2016. The SEC assessment for the B. Voc. (Software development) was conducted on 30th January, 2016, by NASSCOM Sector Skill Council certified assessors.

Fest – Conduire 2017: The Deen Dayal Upadhyay K.A.U.S.H.A.L. Kendra in collaboration with the Department of Management Studies and Department of Economics organised the fest "CONDUIRE" on March 10, 2017 in Ramanujan College premises. CENTRE FOR ROBOTICS AND ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

Centre for Robotics and Artificial Intelligence is working on emerging areas in the field of robotics, embedded systems and machine intelligence. This year, the centre participated in E-Yantra competition organized by IIT Bombay. The students under the centre are currently working on the star innovation project "Robotics in Healthcare" in which we are trying to reduce the costs of existing machines and increasing their efficiency. We are also working on the project "Automatic Irrigation Control Based on Soil Moisture" in collaboration with the Centre for Social Innovation, in which we are building a machine to automate the irrigation process in fields based on the volumetric water content in real time. RAMANUJAN CENTRE FOR APPLIED MATHEMATICS AND RESEARCH

The Centre is currently working on the project titled "*Taking the work of Ramanujan to the next level: An Innovation Project in Cryptography*" under the Star Innovation Projects scheme of the University of Delhi. Initially, the project had a group of 5 students who initiated the study of the basics of cryptography through presentations, talks and group discussion. Students are now working on mini-projects involving the skills of survey writing.

CENTRE FOR HUMAN RIGHTS STUDIES

The Centre for Human Rights Studies has concluded the fourth session (August – November, 2016) of the UGC-sponsored Three Month Certificate Course on Human Rights. Inspired and motivated by the inauguration of this centre by the Director of NCWEB, Dr. Anju Gupta on its orientation day at Ramanujan College, NCWEB held its first annual day of the centre on 4th March, 2017 with fun and fare. DELHI UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF OPEN LEARNING (SOL) CENTRE

STUDENT WELFARE COMMITTEE

The Student Welfare Committee of the College conducted the remedial classes from 17th to 23rd November, 2016. These classes were specially conducted for SC, ST, OBC and Minority students but from this year we opened these classes for General Category students also. In total, around 300 students benefitted from these classes. The classes were conducted for B.A. (Prog.), B.Com. (P), B.Com. (Hons.), B.A. (Hons.) Political Science, B.A.(Hons.) Hindi and B.Sc.(Hons.) Mathematics. The committee also purchased books for relevant subject based on the recommendation of concerned teachers.

FEE CONCESSION COMMITTEE

The Committee financially supports the economically weaker students of the college with high academic potential. In the academic session 2016-17, a sum of Rs. 1,63,340 (by way of Fee Concession and Financial Aid) was given to 88 students. Fee waiver of Rs. 99,275 was also given to 15 students.

DEVELOPMENTS AND INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE

The College has constructed 8 new porta cabins including construction and structure work. Construction of a new Computer Lab equipped with 45 computers was also completed.

- Outreach Programme in collaboration with the NGO, Rupantaran was organized in the Coolie Camp (Vasant Vihar) in May, 2016. It was aimed at motivating the children to go to school and pursue education.
- Community Outreach Programme was organized in Ghalib Auditorium on 12th August, 2016 for school going children from Sudhar Camp (Kalkaji). Students from our College gave short awareness lectures on *Educational Opportunities*, *Physical Health and Sports* and *Sanitation and Hygiene*, under the guidance of faculty members.
- Education-oriented Outreach Programme in collaboration with the NGO Rupantaran was organized in the Coolie Camp (Vasant Vihar) on 4th September, 2016. The main objectives of the event were to make the children of the camp understand the importance and value of education and provide a platform for them to showcase their talent.
- A Talk by Mr. Vivek Sood (Founder and Director, Rupantaran), on the *Importance of Social Outreach* was organized in the College premises on 16th September, 2016.
- A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed by the College and the NGO Rupantaran, under which the College students will provide teaching services to the children and women residing there, while Rupantaran will provide infrastructural facilities. On 23rd October, 2016, the Coolie Camp was formally adopted and our Principal, Dr. S. P. Aggarwal, inaugurated the Sewa Kendra. The objective is to achieve economic self-sufficiency through coaching classes in various subjects, computer classes, spoken English classes, counseling sessions, and interactive sessions through music, street play and dance.

- An Internship Programme has been started by the Committee, under which students are required to complete stipulated hours of teaching upon which they are awarded certificates.
- Swachh Bharat Abhiyan was jointly organised by the Ramanujan College and Rupantaran J.J. Bandhu Camp (Vasant Kunj) on February 5, 2017.
- Inauguration of Computer Centre at J.J. Bandhu Camp (Vasant Kunj) was done as a collaborative initiative for training the children of the camp on 19th February, 2017.

Thrust was formed in October, 2015 to create successful business ventures run by the students. The first venture of Thrust was Society Hunt, 2016. This event was not just a platform to register for societies but it was also a way to showcase the talent and creativity of the various societies in college. The second venture is NetworkN, which is a social entrepreneurship project that will facilitate all NGOs to list on our website. Cartte, the smart design factory aims at creating customized-clothing for societies, individuals, departments and colleges.

ENACTUS RAMANUJAN

Enactus is an international non-profit organization dedicated to inspiring students to improve the world through entrepreneurial action. It is currently operational in over 1700 Universities across 36 Countries. Enactus Ramanujan College, formed in November 2016, is the latest chapter in the Enactus Story. A team of highly enthusiastic students, led by the vision of Faculty Advisors, are currently providing our bit in the accomplishment of 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals using "Social Entrepreneurship". We are currently working on our first project, Project Aakriti which is aimed at the upliftment of Potters in the Uttam Nagar area of New Delhi.
