1. SAKHI CLASSICAL DANCE '26 (Classical Dance Competition by Layatal)

- Group and Duet competition.
- Maximum 4 mins duration.
- Use of fire, smoke, colors is strictly prohibited.
- Soundtrack must be mailed to us before the day of competition.

2. HUSTLE '26 WESTERN DANCE COMPETITION (by DNA Society)

- Each team should consist of 5-25 members. On-stage performers: 5-15 members.
- The Duration of each performance should be between 5-8 minutes + 1 minute setup.
- Fire, smoke, ID cards required.
- Soundtrack must be mailed before fest date.
- Copying past dance sequences leads to mark deduction.

3. LENSACTION ON-THE-SPOT PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION '26 (by First Cut Society)

- Teams of 2-3 from same college.
- Multiple teams per college allowed.
- Own equipment and lights required.
- Only basic editing allowed.
- Entry must include caption.
- JPEG format with EXIF details.

4. NARRATIVE ON-THE-SPOT FILMMAKING COMPETITION '26 (by First Cut Society)

- Teams of 3-5 from same college.
- 4 hours for shooting and editing.
- Film duration: 1-3:30 minutes.

5. Brushstrokes Painting competition (RANGKAAR)

- This is an individual event
- Brushes are not allowed. Participants may use alternative tools such as sponges, palette knives etc.

6. Brushstrokes Portrait making competition (ANIMA)

- This is an individual event.
- Participants must bring all the drawing tools only sheet will be provided.
- Subject/theme will be given on the spot.

7. Brushstrokes Exhibition competition (KALAPHOS)

- Exhibition timings 12:00 PM - 4:00 PM (setup+display)
- Participants must report 30 minutes early for stall setup
- 3. 10ft table will be given, participants must bring all display materials.

8. FLASH FICTION - THE CREATIVE WRITING COMPETITION '26 (by Tark Society)

- Plagiarism is strictly prohibited.
- An on-the-spot writing challenge where a poorly written paragraph is given and must be creatively rewritten.
- No pre-written material, no word limit—bring only your creativity

9. OVERDRIVE - BATTLE OF BANDS '26 (by Shivranjani)

- Each band: 4-8 members.
- 20 minutes total (soundcheck + performance).
- No swapping of band members during the performance on the stage would be allowed.
- Entry would only be given if a valid physical College ID card is produced at the time of entry.

10. PRATIBIMB - GROUP FOLK DANCE COMPETITION '26 (by Nritya Sangam)

- Each team will be given maximum of 10 minutes including stage setup.
- Total 6 teams will be participating in the finals
- Minimum and maximum number of participants should be 6 and 14 respectively.

11. FLAMBOYANCE - FASHION SHOW '26 (by Panache)

- One entry per college.
- Team size: 8-18 members.
- 15 minutes total (setup + performance)

12. THE BILINGUAL POETRY COMPETITION '26 (by Tark Society)

- Round 1 (online) : submit one original poem on the theme "Echo-(तांत्र)".
- Open to interpretation, medium : English/Hindi/Bilingual; free or structured verse.
- No plagiarism or AI Generated content, avoid hateful or abusive language.
- Top 15 entries qualify for the offline final round.
- Round 2 (offline) : word-drop Poetry, pick 2-3 random words, write in 20-30 mins.

13. शिरकत 1.0- THE BILINGUAL CONVENTIONAL DEBATE '26 (by Tark Society)

- This is a team debate (no individual entries); cross-college teams are allowed.
- Each team has two speakers—one for and one against the motion; medium: Hindi or English (same for both).
- Topic released 1 day prior; 3 min speech + 1 min interjection per speaker.

14. MIND MAZE (PRAMANA THE QUIZ SOCIETY)

- The competition will be conducted in English only. Verbal explanation will be bilingual.
- There will be two rounds: Prelims and Mains.
- Candidates can participate either individually or in a team of two.
- The decision of the quiz master will be final in all cases.

15. CUTFRAME- ONLINE FILMMAKING COMPETITION (by FIRST CUT SOCIETY)

- Shortlisted movies will be screened
- 4-5 members from each team will come on screening
